Roadworks Update - the nightworks on Westgate and the Sherborne Road mini roundabout should be nearing completion and we hope you haven't been too disturbed by the noise. It is still very much 'work in progress' and we await to see the final result before we can comment further.

We then expect the contractors to commence work on repairing the Westgate paviours followed by the new 'Dutch' style roundabout at the eastern end. Members have expressed their concerns about the lovely tree in the centre of the existing roundabout and we have been reassured by West Walls Residents' Association that the contractors are fully aware of the importance of the tree, and it is being protected as a key focus point on the roundabout. Details of how they will protect it conform to the relevant (and quite onerous) British Standard.

**Speed Indicating Device (otherwise known as our 'SID')** - Courtesy of the Chichester City Council, we now have a SID on Westgate and you will have noticed it indicating your speed - hopefully 20mph or below! There are two installation points: one next to 25 Westgate which faces traffic going west and the other near the BT phone box by Parklands which faces traffic going east. At the moment we share the SID with two other locations (Broyle Road and the Hornet) and the current schedule is to have the SID working in each location on Westgate for 2 weeks before it is moved on.

The machine records numbers and speeds of vehicles exceeding the speed limit which will be very useful. Individual number plates are <u>not</u> recorded so no letters or fines are issued. We hope that this, together with the efforts of our Westgate Community Speedwatch team with their 'speed gun', will continue to remind motorists that this is a 20mph zone.
